The organizers of the conference invite graduate and undergraduate students in history, art history, religion and humanities in general. The purpose of the conference is to commemorate the 500th anniversary of the Reformation, as well as to discuss issues related to reform movements in broad contexts.

Subject matter:

- Religious movements preceding the reformation of Martin Luther (Hussite, Arianism, etc.)
- Martin Luther as a seminal figure in the Protestant Reformation.
- Reform movements (Lutheranism, Calvinism, Anglicanism, etc.)
- Counter-Reformation (Council of Trent, creation of new religious orders, Index of Forbidden Books etc.)
- Culture, art, architecture, liturgy related to the reformist movements (Protestant church construction, art in the Protestant world, the relationship of particular denominations to the worship of paintings, etc.)
- Relations between churches of different denominations
- History of Protestant communities
- Thinkers of the Reformation era
